## Duty Statement for NRC Project Officer – World Moot Tender Coordinator

### LENGTH OF TERM

Approximately 24 months

### ELIGIBILITY

1. The position of NRC Project Officer – World Moot Tender shall only be open to current invested Rovers.
2. Applicants must be eligible to remain a current invested Rover for the duration of the term.
3. Position is appointed via selection panel, for a 24 month term, with ratification of the appointment taking place at the next available NRC remote meeting.

### DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Project Officer is to coordinate a tender application, for submission to the relevant National Councils, for Scouts Australia to bid to host the 2029 World Moot. The Project Officer will:

1. Produce a project timeline of key milestones and deliverables.
2. Recommend to the NRC how the project timeline will be delivered, including consideration of working group/s, team structure and allocating milestones.
3. Consult the Queensland BRC in regards to the project, noting that they are currently scheduled to host the 18<sup>th</sup> Australian Moot in 2029.

### NOTES

The position of Project Officer – World Moot Tender is a standing project officer role and a non-executive role of the National Rover Council.
